Dear Parent / Guardian,

In an effort to offer affordable transportation for those families with economic hardship, the district will be offering free transportation and elimination of Pay to Participate fees to those families who qualify for free meal benefits and the price will be half for those families that qualify for reduced meals. In order to participate in these discounts, the family must present their school year 2011 meal benefit qualification letter to their home school. This letter will be sent to you from the Food Service Department once your application has been received and processed. Please note that the federal government allows 10 days for the processing of these applications. Applications will be available at the Central Office, High School, and online by July 6. Return your completed application to the Central Office for expedited processing.

Due to statutes in the Federal Meals Program, the Food Service Department cannot provide free and reduced application results to the schools on your behalf. The purpose for these regulations is to preserve the identity of students participating in the program. Thus, the parent or guardian must provide this information. Please be assured that confidentiality is always of utmost importance.

It is important to note that benefits will be provided upon approval of the 2010-2011 meal benefit application. Again, applications will be available on July 6 at the Central Office and online at www.ftcsc.k12.in.us.
